- 1. It is free to search for continuing education courses in CE Broker.**
Please select option three “Search for Courses by Profession”
- 2. It is free to enter your continuing education credits in CE Broker.**
Please select option two “Limited Access Registration”.
- 3. Florida approved providers are required to report continuing education hours to CE Broker for attendees.**
- 4. If you obtained coursework from a nationally approved provider, it is to your advantage to self-submit your hours to CE Broker in order for the courses to be added to your transcript.**
- 5. If you are selected for an audit and your transcript is complete in CE Broker, you automatically pass the continuing education audit and you will not receive an audit letter.**
- 6. Full access subscription to CE Broker is optional**

The CE Broker system is the Florida Department of Health continuing education tracking database. CE Providers began submitting licensee CE course completions to the CE tracking system (CE Broker) on January 1, 2004, in accordance with Florida Statute 456.025(7). Course completions submitted to CE Broker (www.cebroke.com) will be used to determine that licensees have met their continuing education requirements at the end of the effective license renewal period.
